

## The Pollution Peril of the Niger River

This book examined the different types of pollution of the Niger River, as well as their consequences, known and visible, subtler and more unsuspected, but all as perilous. This book on the pollution peril brings scientific clarifications on the mechanisms of contamination of various types of pollutants and their impact on animal and plant species. It also reviews the physical environment of the Niger River Basin, in a simple language accessible to non-specialists. The author proposes some possible solutions to prevent, limit and reduce the growing pollution of the Niger River.
